Year 4 Autumn Term 2015

As Scientists we will investigate the many aspects of sound. We will study various methods of producing sound and discover how the sounds are transferred to our ears



We will also be learning about how to construct electrical circuits

In our investigations we will be learning how to plan a fair test and give reasons for our results.

In ICT we will be using a music composition programme incorporating aspects learned in our first science unit.

We will also be learning about computer programming.

In RE we will be answering the following questions:

How and why do religious people show care for each other?

Why do Christians Call Jesus the light of the world?



As Performers we will listen carefully to patterns in music and perform with more control and awareness to our audience.

As Musicians we will be learning to play the ukulele.

Focussing on the Anglo Saxons and Vikings, as Historians we will explore the different ways we can find out about the past and how to understand the evidence. We will consider how groups of people and events have influenced our lives.



As Geographers we will be practising our mapping skills by locating significant places in the UK and beyond that were significant in Anglo Saxon and Viking times. We will also be comparing land use and the types of settlements.

As Artists and Designers we will be researching designing and making our own Anglo Saxon helmets. Through creating illuminated letters, we will experiment in creating mood and feelings with colour, creating striking effects with a limited palette. We will also be developing our understanding of textiles through weaving.

In PE we will develop our ball skills through games whilst also enhancing teamwork skills. Through gymnastics we will be looking at ways to improve balance.



In French we will be learning how to talk about ourselves using words and phrases.
